FULL-TIME STUDY

Full-time study is 20 hours/week of class time with approximately 10 hours/week of homework. A full-time student studies Monday - Thursday from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. & 1:00 - 3:00 p.m. There are no classes on Fridays.

CORE COURSES

Core courses integrate all language skills: listening, speaking, reading, writing and grammar. These courses are designed to help develop English skills for post secondary study or employment. Low intermediate (CLB 5) to advanced levels (CLB 8).
Monday - Thursday 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. (12 hours / week).

SKILL COURSES

Skill courses focus on one skill area. Each term students have a choice of skill courses focused on each of the language strands: listening/speaking, reading, writing and grammar. These courses provide extra practice for a student's weaker skills.
Monday & Wednesday 1:00 - 3:00 p.m. (4 hours / week)
Tuesday & Thursday 1:00 - 3:00 p.m. (4 hours / week)

ACCELERATED ACADEMIC PREPARATION II

4 months course

This course focuses on the academic skills needed to be successful in college, university or technical school. Coursework includes reading academic texts, doing research, writing essays on academic topics and making formal presentations.

Note: Accelerated Academic Preparation II is accepted to meet the language requirement for career programs at SAIT, Bow Valley College and DeVry.

FEES FOR STUDENTS UNDER 20

- Full-time for 7 weeks (1 term):
 - 20 hours/week \$120 & \$95 for books
- Part-time for 7 weeks (1 term):
 - 1 core course (12 hours/week - 4 mornings) \$60 & \$95 for books
 - 2 skill courses (8 hours/week - 4 afternoons) \$60

FEES FOR STUDENTS 20 AND OVER

- Full-time for 7 weeks (1 term):
 - 20 hours/week \$1170 & \$95 for books
- Part-time for 7 weeks (1 term):
 - 1 core course (12 hours/week - 4 mornings) \$700 & \$95 for books
 - 1 skill courses (4 hours/week - 2 afternoons) \$235
